TERMS OF REFERENCE

AIM:

The aim of the group is to support St Luke's staff to implement best practice strategies in environmental responsibility in order to minimise energy, water and resource usage.

KEY FUNCTIONS:

- 1 To research evolving 'world's best practices' in energy and resource use to implement across St Lukes workplaces.
- 2 To monitor resource use throughout St Lukes including: water, power, petrol and paper.
- 3 To recommend to the CEO and CFO, through the Senior Management Group, strategies for developing improved environmental strategies.
- 4 To participate in Budget processes where proposed environmental strategies have significant cost implications.
- 5 To be a catalyst for greater environmental awareness in all St Lukes staff, volunteers, clients and customers through education, promotions and events.
- 6 To engage consultants in on-going coaching and particular projects.

OPERATIONS:

- 1 To meet bi-monthly
- 2 To maintain a core group of 6 participants as nominated with an open-door policy for other interested staff.
